## Dear Vermont Academy Community,

Our country's second President, John Adams, famously said, "Every problem is an opportunity in disguise." This past year surely tested this adage – and I firmly believe it to be true. I have watched my administrative team, faculty, and students wrestle with problems that, in the end, have made us all better.

So, as I share this year's annual report with you, one word comes to mind: Grateful.

Since last winter, I have seen so many wonderful acts of kindness and generosity. I have witnessed so many people striving to be their best selves. While it might be easy to feel overwhelmed, I am hopeful and grateful.

I am grateful for the amazing work completed by our faculty and staff. Last spring, when the COVID-19 pandemic spread quickly and the Governor of Vermont shut down schools for the remainder of the year, our faculty and staff rallied. They created an online curriculum that gained high praise from parents and students alike. They developed virtual student life activities that maintained our community connection across time zones. A core group met tirelessly for hours on end, month after month, to reopen the school in a safe and healthy way. Countless investments were made to the campus, including temporary outdoor classrooms, personal protective measures like plexiglass shields in bathrooms, and the donation of antigen testing machines to allow for rapid Covid-19 testing. We created new outdoor traditions like movies and video games projected on Horowitz Performing Arts Hall and glow-in-the-dark volleyball tournaments. The result: Our student body has never been healthier! And we have not had a case of Covid-19 on campus this year.

I am especially grateful for the generosity of our supporters. While the world's economy ground to a halt with factories and businesses shuttered, while unemployment figures climbed to record highs, and while financial markets faced a questionable future, our alumni, faculty, staff, parents and students helped us shatter our fundraising records. Our "One Day for VA" fundraising event on May 5 raised over \$178,000 with 369 donors – well over twice the amount raised the previous year! Mr. Dick Whitcomb '55 gave a generous \$50,000 match that compelled others to dig deep, and he deserves special thanks, as does Herb Ellis '53, whose significant gift pushed us over the top! The success of this day and the willingness of our supporters to stretch and donate more than ever before pushed our annual fund past its \$850,000 goal to \$1,021,836 – a new record! Thank you so much for your support.

I am grateful for our school's core beliefs. Two specific ones come to mind: "Each member of the Vermont Academy community cultivates strengths and seeks to overcome challenges," and "Each member of the Vermont Academy community seeks and gives help when appropriate." Since March of last year, nothing has gone as planned. Yet time and time again, our community has adjusted, has learned, has coped, and has succeeded in finding light and passion and success during a time when many have not. Our students will only become stronger by living through these times and by watching us overcome the challenges we face, whether through our own strengths or through the help of others like you.

## The Vermont Academy Giving Societies

The Horace Mann Willard Society: \$1,000–\$2,499. Recognizes the contribution of Dr. Horace Mann Willard, first principal of Vermont Academy.




