

World History Summer School Cost of Summer School: \$975; School hours: 8:30AM - 12:30PM May 31 - June 2 (Wednesday – Friday) June 5 – 9 (Monday – Friday) June 12 – 16 (Monday – Friday) June 20 – 23 (Tuesday – Friday) June 26 - 30 (Monday - Friday)

Summer School Policy:

- 1. A summer course requires unsupervised work at home. Students must be disciplined, self-motivated and able to work independently. If you cannot maintain focus in a class for 4 hours and complete assigned work each afternoon you should not take summer school. Applicants are reviewed for acceptance by current teachers, counselors and administration based upon grades and progress in 2022-23 school year, ability to move at a fast pace and discipline.
- 2. A completed application does not mean acceptance. Applications will be reviewed and accepted on a first-come-first-served policy. A date and time stamp will be assigned when the application is received.
- Students cannot take an additional ILT and cannot take more than 2 non-core electives during the regular school year. Fine Arts Block (FAB) electives do **NOT** count as 1 of the 2 non-core electives. Summer school does NOT guarantee you will receive your 1st choice electives next year.
- 4. HC summer courses receive a numeric grade for both semesters of the course and are reflected in the GPA.
- 5. No more than 3 absences are allowed, regardless of the reason. Students with more than 3 absences will not receive credit or a refund. Summer school students cannot combine additional activities that conflict with summer school times or dates that cause them to have more than 3 absences. Please check your camp/athletic/vacation calendar before signing up for summer school. More than 15 minutes of tardiness to class will count as 1 full day of absence.
- 6. HC reserves the right to dismiss any student, without refund, who in conduct, industry or progress proves out of harmony with HC standards. Dress code will be casual, modest and in good taste (uniforms are **NOT** required).
- 7. A \$75 late fee will be assessed for applications received April 1 or after. Refunds for cancellation (minus \$75) will be granted if requested by May 1. No tuition refunds will be made after May 1.
- 8. At least 12 students must register in order for the course to be offered. A maximum of 16 will be allowed in World History.
- 9. PCR Services and Accommodations may not be available. The testing center **will not be open**.
- 10. Students must follow the guidelines of the HC Mission Statement, rules and regulations in the HC Student Handbook and in accordance with the rules and policies described in the student's enrollment contract.
- 11. NO final exams can be taken early and must be taken on June 30th. No exceptions.
