**Conference:** Global Student Leadership Summit (GSLs)

**What:** GSLs is the first truly large scale, international, multi-day leadership summit for youth from around the globe. This will be the largest multi-day student leadership event in the world and will welcome over 2,000 youth and educators from over 20 countries, for three days of inspiring speakers, interactive workshops and peer collaboration. GSLs will be a life-changing marquee event for the future leaders of the world. The event is run by Canada's premier student leadership organization, Youth Leadership Camps Canada, and will be filled with substantive information, real people, making real change, and an unbridled dose of positive energy.

**When:** April 18-21, 2020

**Cost:** \$900 includes registration fee, flights, hotel accommodation including breakfast, and a Selwyn leadership hoodie. Extra spending money is required for other meals.

**Conference:** CAIS Senior Student Leadership Conference "Swim Against the Current"

## **Canadian Student Leadership Conference (CSLC) 2020**

Pre-Conference (Sept. 19 - 21)

Main Conference (Sept. 22 - 29)

**Conference:** Canadian Student Leadership Conference "From The Roots Up"

**What:** CSLC 2020 in Yorkton, Saskatchewan will be the 36th annual meeting of approximately 800 student leaders and staff advisors from across the country. The conference is centered around YOU as a student leader and how you can empower yourself to be a force of change in your school and your community. You'll hear inspiring messages from authors, Olympians, professional athletes and more. In addition, it's an opportunity to meet students from all across Canada, and gain ideas for making Selwyn an even better school for all.

**Where:** Regina/Yorkton (Pre-Conference) and Yorkton, SK (Yorkton Regional High School)

**When:** Pre-Conference Sept. 19 - 21, Conference Sep. 22 - 29, 2020 (Including travel days)

**Cost:** \$450 conference registration fee and leadership swag, approximately \$750 return flight\*\*, and extra spending money. During the Main Conference students are billeted with local families in single-gender groups, with at least one other Selwyn boy where possible.

Possible \$600 Pre-Conference fee which covers accommodations, sightseeing, and meals). *Attendance at the Pre-Conference will be decided upon by the consensus of the group of delegates.*
