BYOD Minimum Specs Communication for 2023-24

For 2023/24, students in Grade 9-12 are required to bring their own device to school and use it when it is deemed necessary for educational purposes. This includes PC laptops or tablets and Macbooks, iPads (with external keyboard) and Chromebooks.

Students registering for the following courses & activities are expected to have a PC laptop running Windows 10 or above, or a Mac laptop running Monterey OS or above. Students with iPads or Chromebooks will be unable to run the software required for these courses.
