- We will have use of a private coach and driver while touring for the next four days.

DAY 5 Thursday, 13 January 2022

- Spend the morning volunteering in La Carpio.
- Spend some time in the Artisan open-air market that sells everything from handcrafted jewelry elaborate woodwork and Guatemalan sarongs. Then enjoy an afternoon excursion with the children of La Carpio. We may visit the zoo, a dairy farm, a pottery factory, an animal rescue shelter, or the children's museum. After our visit, we will return to La Carpio or organize donations and enjoy a play by the Costa Rica Humanitarian Foundation staff.

DAY 6 Friday, 14 January 2022

- We will have use of a private coach and driver for our overnight excursion to Arenal this weekend.
- Our International Studies Abroad staff will accompany us on our excursion.
- Arenal is famous for its Volcano, an unavoidable presence while traveling within this part of the country. It is tall and imposing and has a reputation that precedes itself. Arenal's perfectly symmetrical shape makes it a sightseer's dream.
- Our accommodation for the next night will be in Arenal. While here, we will enjoy breakfast at the hotel.
- Visit the Baldi Hot Springs and take the opportunity to submerge yourself in the natural medicinal waters. The springs include several pools of varying temperatures, all surrounded by nature. While here, we will enjoy a traditional Costa Rican lunch or dinner.
- This evening we will enjoy a traditional Costa Rican dinner. Traditional Costa Rican meals can include: Gallo pinto, cheese tortilla, salad, sweet plantains, and a Costa Rican refreshment.

DAY 7 Saturday, 15 January 2022

- Enjoy an exhilarating bird's eye view of the rain forest canopy while flying through one of the world's largest zipline systems.
- This afternoon we will return to Heredia.
