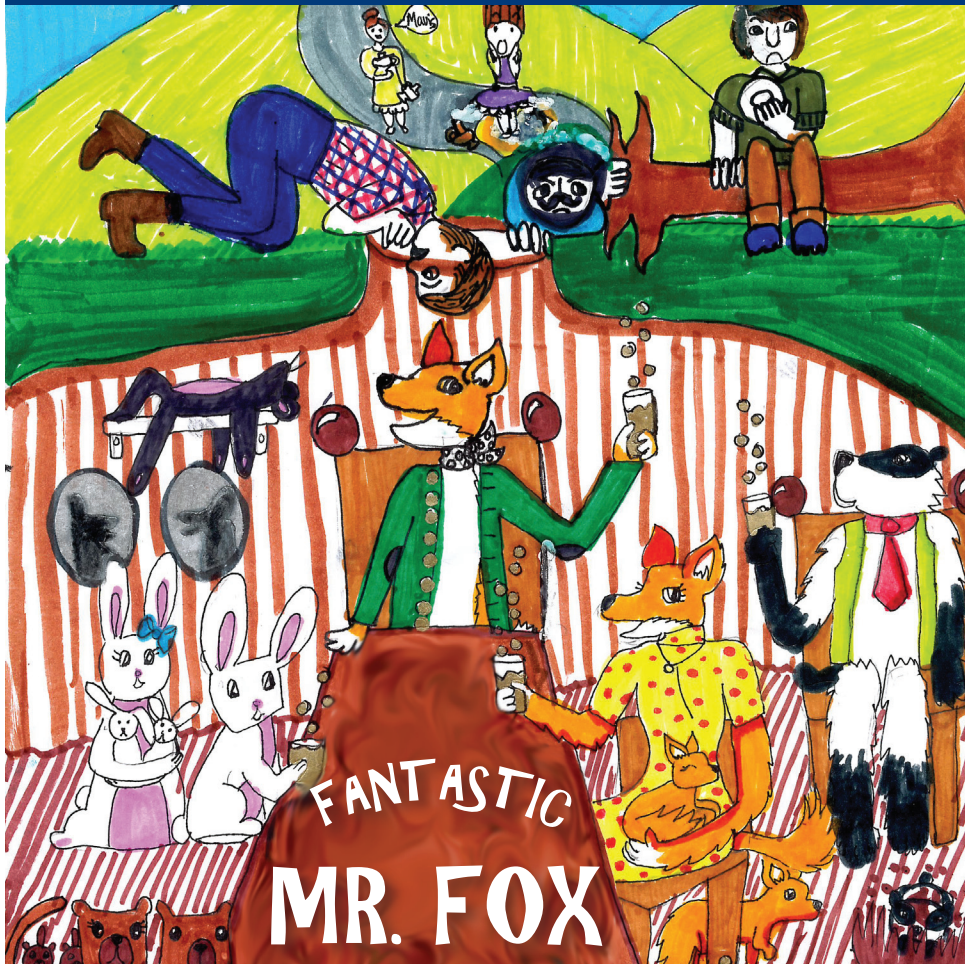

A Note From the Director

Welcome to our production of *Fantastic Mr. Fox!*

I fell in love with Roald Dahl years ago while reading his novel, *The Witches*, to a group of children. I was captivated with the story, and had to read everything he wrote. My favorite book is probably *Boy*, his autobiography, which helps one understand why some of his characters are so revolting. His books continue to be popular with children and adults today and many of his stories are made into movies and musicals. *Matilda* is in production today and *Charlie and The Chocolate Factory* is headed to Broadway.

As I directed *Fantastic Mr. Fox*, my goal was to get the actors to dig deep and do their best to create believable characters. We had to think like foxes, badgers, groundhogs, weasels, rabbits, chickens, not to mention rats! As a cast we asked questions such as, "Is it okay for the fox to steal chickens to feed his family, even though stealing is wrong?" "How can the farmers defend their farms against the fox with just shovels, rakes and torches?" "How do we work as a team to bring the story to life?" We made choices as a group and helped each other grow. It has been an honor to work with your children!

My colleagues, Zachary Hanna, Karen Cahill, Carlye Porrazzo, Melinda Keane, Bryan Dauterive, Mary Mayer and Spencer Keane, brought their special gifts and talents to work each day and without them this production would not have happened.
