

FACULTY BIOS



Holly Mehling Director of Dance Conservatory

Holly Mehling holds a Bachelor of Arts in Theatre from California State University, Chico and a Master of Fine Arts in Dance from the University of California, Irvine. She has been dancing since 1975 and has taught all levels of ballet, tap, jazz, contemporary, social dance, and Pilates for over 25 years at many schools and conservatories including: University of California, Irvine, Chapman

University, Irvine Valley College, Mira Costa College, Focus Dance Center, Ballet Pacifica, and Orange County High School of the Arts. As a graduate fellow at UCI, Holly taught three levels of Ballet, Social Dance, and Undergraduate Dance Philosophy, Aesthetics & Criticism. Upon graduation, she returned to UCI to teach all levels of tap. Recently, she has been a guest lecturer in Dance Pedagogy at Orange Coast College. For seven years, Mrs. Mehling performed professionally with the Los Angeles-based rhythm tap company, Rhapsody in Taps, which tours nationally and abroad. Some of her other professional performing credits include Fox's MadTV, Ballet Pacifica's Nutcracker, and Chico City Light Opera (performer and choreographer). In 2013, Mrs. Mehling completed a RYT-200 Yoga Certification at Yoga Shakti. Additionally, Mrs. Mehling is an ABT® Certified Teacher, who has successfully completed the ABT® Teacher Training Intensive in Pre-Primary through Level 3 of the ABT® National Training Curriculum. She has directed and taught in the Dance Program and Conservatory at St. Margaret's since 2001. Holly is a proud mom of two wonderful sons, Tedd and Miles.



Jamie Leneau, Director of Middle and Upper School Dance Program

Mrs. Jamie Leneau has taught at St. Margaret's since 2007 and currently teaches dance for the Preschool, Lower School, Middle School and Upper School programs. She has been dancing since 1981. Mrs. Leneau was the Head Cheerleading Coach for St. Margaret's for five years. She is originally from Texas where she taught jazz, modern, ballet and tap to students ages 3 to adult.

During her dance studies at the University of Texas at Arlington, she danced with the university's undergraduate performing dance company, was awarded the Dance Ensemble Scholarship two years in a row and was honored at the Presidents Convocation. Upon graduation, she taught dance classes at UTA and directed the university's undergraduate performing company for five years. Mrs. Leneau taught master classes in jazz at the American College Dance Festival South Central Region from 2002 to 2006. At the University of California, Irvine, Mrs. Leneau taught jazz and social dance classes and was the assistant to renowned choreographer Loretta Livingston for two years. Her graduate thesis examined how to best meet the needs of dancers with physical challenges within the university's dance curriculum. She has guest choreographed and taught for Laguna Beach High School's dance program. She holds a Bachelor of Arts in Interdisciplinary Studies from the University of Texas at Arlington, having graduated Magna Cum Laude, and a Master of Fine Arts in Dance from the University of California, Irvine. Jamie is the proud mom of two Wee Tartans, Isaiah and Dominic.
