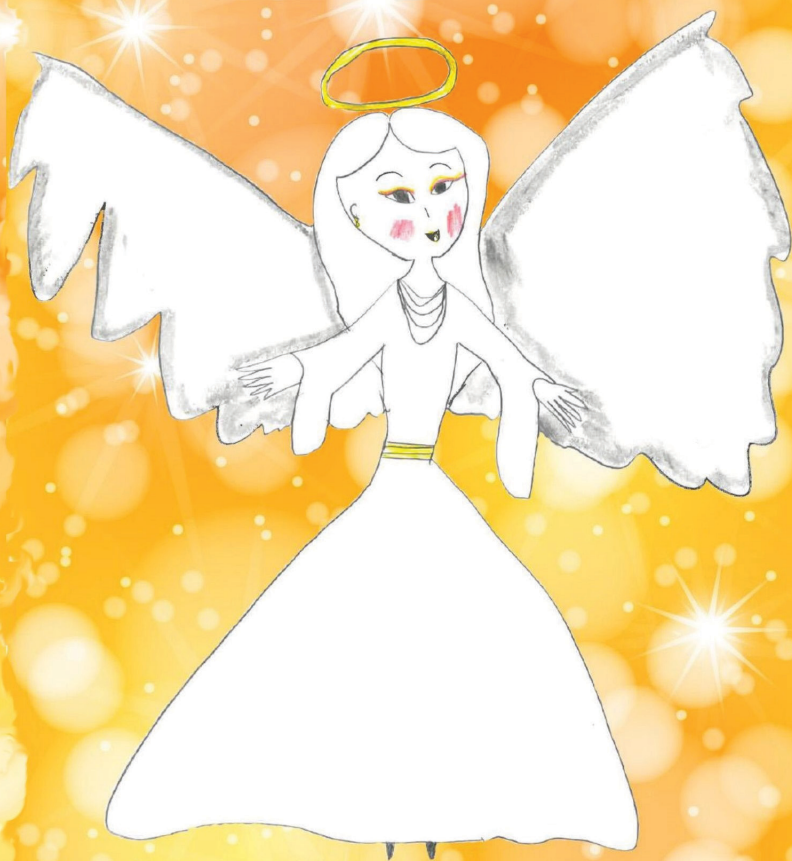

CHRIS CARBAJAL (Band Director) conducts grades 6-12 Concert Bands, Jazz Ensemble and teaches Advanced Placement (AP) Music Theory. He also teaches private woodwind lessons and serves on the panel of judges for the OC Register's Artist of the Year program. As an active musician, he plays the saxophone for legendary Iranian singer, Ebi, and plays saxophone and does musical arrangements for Bonnie Foster. Mr. Carbajal has performed with jazz greats such as Andy McGhee, Walter Beasley, Bill Holman, Wayne Bergeron, Nicholas Payton, James Moody, and Dave Liebman. He has also toured with Save Ferris and performed with Barry Manilow, appearing on his latest music videos from the album *The Greatest Songs from the 80s*. He earned a Bachelor of Arts from the Berklee College of Music in Boston, Mass. and a Master of Music in Music Education from Boston University in Boston, Mass. Recently he was a panel speaker at the Grammy Museum for the Berklee College of Music Newly Accepted Student Event.



STACEY MILES (Choral Director) has been teaching at St. Margaret's since 2004, and has experience ranging from pre-kindergarten through grade 12. Her vocal credits include roles in *Bye Bye Birdie*, *L'Elixir d'Amore* and three years as principal vocalist in Cirque du Soleil's production of *Mystère* at Treasure Island Hotel in Las Vegas. In 1992, she sang soprano with the Westminster Symphonic Choir on a recording of Leoncavallo's *I Pagliacci* performed in Carnegie Hall, with the title role sung by the late legendary tenor Luciano Pavarotti. As a soprano, Mrs. Miles has toured Great Britain with The Princeton Singers, a professional choir from Princeton, NJ, and has been a member of, and Grammy winner with, the Los Angeles Chamber Singers and Cappella from 2004 until the ensemble's final concert in 2015. Most recently, she served as the Soprano soloist at the Mission Basilica cathedral, as well as singing and recording with De Angelis Vocal Ensemble. Mrs. Miles earned degrees in Music Education and Sacred Music from Westminster Choir College in Princeton, NJ, both with minors in Vocal Performance and Choral Conducting.



ADELA KWAN NETH (Accompanist) received her M.F.A in collaborative piano from the University of California, Irvine. She enjoys a career as an accompanist, pedagogue, and collaborative pianist. Mrs. Neth has been a participant in master classes and residencies with notables such as Menahem Pressler, John Perry, and Morten Lauridsen and has participated in and won various music festivals and competitions. Principal teachers include Charlotte Zelka, Macy Zeng, and Dr. Lorna Griffitt. Mrs. Neth maintains full studios in Los Angeles and Orange counties and is a sought-after collaborative pianist and accompanist.



GENE WIE (Orchestra Director) appears internationally as a conductor, chamber musician, and educator. His performances on violin, viola, clarinet, and saxophone have brought him across the United States, Canada, Japan, France, Italy, Austria, Switzerland, Slovenia, Croatia, Australia, and New Zealand, and into major venues such as the Sydney Opera House, the Salzburg Mozarteum, and Prague Liechtenstein Palace. From Founder and First Violin of the Elegie and Monarch String Quartets, Concertmaster of the Blackbird Music Project, and Principal Clarinet of the South Orange County Chamber Orchestra, to Conductor of the String and Concert Orchestras at the Orange County School of the Arts and currently Music Director of the Community Youth Orchestra of Southern California, Mr. Wie has helped shape the direction of ensemble education in Orange County since 2003. A member of the St. Margaret's faculty since 2006, he teaches orchestral ensembles and chamber music in grades 4 through 12, coordinates music outreach to local preschool programs, collaborates with numerous colleagues in the Suzuki String Academy, Piano Academy, and Musical Theater, and is the Founding Artistic Director of the St. Margaret's Summer Music Festival. In a unique dual role on campus, he also teaches Advanced Placement (AP) Computer Science and Introduction to Software Engineering courses. He earned MFA Music and BS Information and Computer Science degrees from the University of California at Irvine. www.genewie.com
