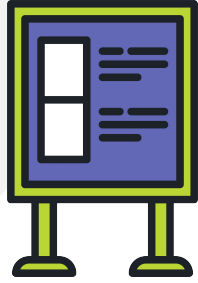


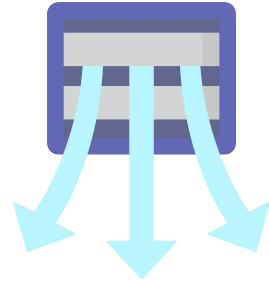

Signage throughout school noting mask and social distancing protocols



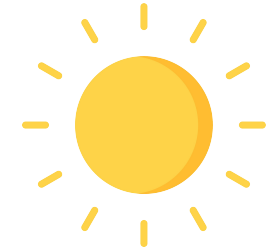
Design of our campus optimizes air flow; HVAC enhanced with MERV-13

Mitigation Protocols



Mask Wearing

- Everyone on campus must wear masks **at all times** except when eating regardless of vaccination status.
- Masks and other PPE will be provided by Archer when needed.



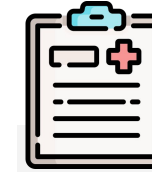
Hand Washing/ Hygiene

- Frequent hand washing and/or sanitizing is required.
- Touchless hand sanitizers are stationed throughout campus.
- Disinfect supplies between groups.



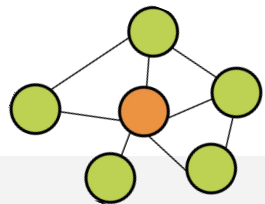
Social Distancing

- All students and employees must practice social distancing..
- There is strong evidence that maintaining at least 3 feet and ideally 6 feet of distance from others is critical in curbing the spread of COVID-19.



Symptoms Screening

- Everyone visiting the Archer campus must submit a pre-screening questionnaire daily including a self check of temperature.



Contact Tracing

- Archer is following federal, state, and local isolation and quarantine protocols related to symptomatic individuals and positive cases.



Surveillance Testing

- Archer is performing biweekly surveillance testing on campus.
- We require all students, faculty, staff, and contractors to participate in our surveillance testing program regardless of vaccination status.



Vaccinations

- **All eligible students, faculty, staff, and contractors are required to be fully vaccinated.**
- Students who have not yet reached the age of 12 will be required to be vaccinated within 8 weeks of eligibility.



Travel

- Archer is following federal, state, and local COVID-19 travel quarantine guidelines.
